Let's come to the good news, after submitting our Expression of Interest to Aberdeenshire Council for the Community Asset Transfer of the Mill of Benholm in May, we had a meeting with some members of the Aberdeenshire Asset Transfer Group. The trustees handed over the Strategy Paper for the Community Asset Transfer of the Mill of Benholm from Aberdeenshire Council to the Mill of Benholm Enterprise (SCIO). We explained the plans for the revival of the Mill of Benholm, including the funding strategy, to the Council officers who were present. After this meeting and further internal discussions within Aberdeenshire Council, we have been asked by the Project Officer to submit the formal Application for the Community Asset Transfer.

The Board of the Mill of Benholm Enterprise is preparing this currently and will submit the application soon.

A further site visit with relevant officers of Aberdeenshire Council is planned to establish how Mill of Benholm Enterprise and Aberdeenshire Council can work together constructively to open the site in the meantime, even if it is just the grounds to begin with.

We have held many stakeholder meetings on site with people and organisations who are interested in helping with the revival of the Mill of Benholm and using the buildings and the grounds. If you know of anyone who would like to be part of this project or maybe a business who would be interested in using parts of the site or buildings, please get in contact.
