

CAFE AT THE MILL

Mill of Benholm



The Mill of Benholm in the People's Journal 1934

Historic records suggest that there may have been a mill in the Parish of Benholm from the late 12th century, they certainly associate the Mill to the Kirkton of Benholm in the early 16th century. The meal mill's current earliest remains are thought to be over 300 years old, with rebuilding and extension in 1817, at the time of agricultural improvements in the parish.



Garden's Map of Kincardineshire (1774): The kirk and manse are illustrated between the two river crossings on the earlier 'coach road', and the mill a little further south close to the convergence of the two water courses. Note Annie's Dam at the northern boundary of the parish. Annie's Dam was an additional water reservoir to supplement the water in the Mill Dam if needed
